Parking Permit Rules and Regulations

Parking is a privilege and may be suspended or revoked at any time. This includes falling out of good academic standing or behavior issues.

1. All parking on school property is by **permit only** (Vehicles on property may be subject to administrative search).
2. The vehicle must be owned by the student and/or their parent/guardian.
3. Students approved for this privilege have been granted permission to **park only the vehicle registered above**. Unregistered vehicles parked on school property without the permission of the Administration will be removed at the owner's expense.
4. **Students are not to loan their permits to any other students.**
5. **If you do drive a different vehicle to school, it is your obligation to make the Main Office aware of the vehicle change that you have that day, immediately upon your arrival to school.**
6. Students will update their parking information within twenty-four hours of any **permanent** change in information.
7. Students must arrive at school in plenty of time, even during winter months, in order to be in school on time and ready for all classes. **Three incidences of tardiness or truancy during a marking period will result in the loss of parking privileges. To regain parking privileges the following marking period, an updated application will be required and reinstatement of those privileges are subject to Administrative review and approval. Students will only be allowed this opportunity once during the year.**
8. **Students must be passing all classes required to graduate in order to retain a parking pass.**
9. All students must enter the building through the main entrance.
10. Students are to exercise **good traffic safety practices on and off school grounds. Reckless driving on school grounds will result in the loss of parking privileges.**
11. During school hours, student operated vehicles will be parked in designated numbered spots. Cars not parked in a designated space will be towed at the owner's expense.
12. Students are not allowed to go to their vehicles or to the parking lot during the school day without prior permission from the Administration.
13. Obey the school speed limit of 10 MPH on all school property.
14. Any student in the possession of, or using, alcohol, drugs, and/or weapons is subject to losing their parking privilege immediately.
15. The towing of any vehicles will be at the owner's expense. The school is under no obligation to warn students.
16. Driving to CiTi BOCES is not allowed without prior written permission from CiTi BOCES administration and high school administration.
17. Any items not covered in this document will be at the Administrators' discretion.

Parent or Guardian:

The first responsibility your child has is getting an education. If they are having problems at school meeting their academic and/or behavioral obligations, including being late for school, they may lose their parking privilege. Please remember that work, early dismissal, and extracurricular activities are secondary concerns. **Please make sure that you review this parking application with your child and discuss with them that this is a privilege that the school offers and that it may be revoked at the Administrator's discretion.**

Please sign the acknowledgement below indicating that both you and your child accept the responsibility of parking at the high school, your signature also indicates that the information submitted is correct and that you will adhere to all school rules in order to sustain your parking privilege. You also understand that the privilege to park on school property may be suspended or revoked for violation of these and other school rules. In addition, you recognize the fact that all vehicles are subject to being towed at the owner's expense and that the school district is not responsible for the vehicle or its contents while the vehicle is on school property. (We recommend that your vehicle remain locked at all times)
