In **Math** topics covered will be:

Ratios and Proportional Relationships, Number Systems, Expressions, Equations, Inequalities, Geometry, Statistics and Probability.

In **Science** you will study the inner workings of chemistry, getting all the way down to atoms, and looking into the many principals of physics, which govern our everyday lives. In addition, you will work on skills from previous scientific disciplines and master new scientific skills in lab.

In **Social Studies** topics covered will be:

American history, from Pre-Columbian period up to the end of the Civil War. We will also focus heavily on historical thinking skills such as sourcing documents, as well as identifying audience, purpose, point of view, bias, and historical context of those documents.

In **English**, you will be reading both fiction and nonfiction books to help you become independent thinkers and dig deep into the meaning of the texts. You will be collaborating with your peers, creating visual projects, and utilizing critical thinking skills throughout the school year. Our themes for our four units include survival, finding one's voice, turning tough times into resilience, and science & innovation.

Mrs. Watson will be the resource teacher on team who will be co-teaching core classes, as well as providing 7th grade pullout resource services.
