Dear Parents/Guardians,

We were notified this morning that a staff member at Central Square Middle School has tested positive for COVID-19. The staff member was not at school during any part of the staff member's contagious period so **no** students or staff members were at risk of exposure.

We have been contacted daily by the Onondaga County and Oswego County Health Departments informing us not only of all students and staff that have tested positive for COVID-19, but also all of the students and staff that they have deemed "close contacts" that require a quarantine. **Just recently, the New York State Health Department has changed their quarantine guidelines.** Previously, someone considered to be a "close contact" by the Health Department was required to quarantine for a total of 14 days from their last exposure to someone that tested positive for COVID-19. **Moving forward, as long as the person being quarantined <u>is symptom free during their first ten days of quarantine</u>, they can return to work and school the next day (without a COVID-19 negative test) with continued symptom monitoring and masking through Day 14, as seen here, <u>https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/more/scientific-brief-options-to-reduce-quarantine.html</u>.**

The New York State Health Department has now aligned their quarantine guidelines to the CDC's quarantine guidelines (seen in the link above). We were told to expect several more COVID-19 cases and mandatory quarantines over the next two weeks following our holiday recess. We will continue to inform all of the parents/guardians of all COVID-19 cases that take place in their child's school.
