This morning, September 15, we were notified that a member of the varsity football team has tested positive for COVID 19. Based on the Health Department's contact tracing protocols/mandates, we have nearly 20 varsity football players who have entered a mandatory 10-day quarantine period by the Oswego County Health Department. After conferring with Superintendent Colabufo and Coach Matteson we have determined that we cannot safely proceed with our scheduled football game and senior night festivities scheduled for this Friday night against CBA. With so many players out on quarantine, it would not be safe to play a game with so few players. Although we are very disappointed in this development, we are happy to be able to reschedule the senior night festivities to the October 8 game against Carthage, which will also serve as our homecoming game. Our coaches and players will remain steadfast in overcoming this latest setback and look forward to your support as we continue our season next week at Fulton.
