Transportation of Student Athletes

Student athletes cannot be released to another student and/or the parents of another students.

Members of athletic teams must travel to and from athletic contests via CSSD transportation with the following exceptions:

In accordance with School Law 22:7:

a. Athletes can only be released directly to their parents/ guardians. There must be personal contact between a parent and the coaches, and a sign out procedure before the student can be released.

The coach will carefully explain this policy and procedure at the beginning of each season to all team members. Parents who have questions on this policy can contact the Athletic Director's office.

Should there be an extenuating circumstance that you would need a relative to pick up your student athlete from an away contest, please make sure you complete the Relative Pick –up Release form, found on the CSSD website under athletics/forms. This will need to be approved by your athlete's current coach prior to the game.
