Code 15 Professional Salaries	As the District moves forward operating schools and meeting the needs of students, we plan to use this funding to help continue to retain two Assistant Principal positions. This will allow us to meet the increased needs of the students as well as reduce the student to adult ratio. The District will add a Director of Academic Supports and Interventions, whose primary focus will be to coach staff on best practices to implement at Tier 1, 2, and 3 interventions.
Code 16 Support Staff Salaries	These funds will allow us the ability to reinstate the LAN (Local Area Network) Technician position. This position is essential in supporting the technology department and their goals. Also, included here is an additional RN (Registered Nurse) to safely return students to in-person instruction. We learned as we transitioned to larger numbers of students "in-person", more support staff is needed to implement the public health emergency regulations. School nurses need additional support and adding a district wide RN to the staff will help facilitate COVID protocols, including contract tracing, health screenings, temperature checks, immunizations, etc.
