Dear Parents/Guardians,

- We were notified this afternoon (Tuesday, December 15) that a student who attends Brewerton Elementary has tested positive for COVID-19. We immediately contacted the Onondaga County Health Department and provided them with the names of all students and staff that were in close contact with the student that tested positive for COVID-19 during the first 48 hours of the student's contagious period. The Principal is currently making all of the phone calls to the parents of students (and staff members) deemed "close contacts" by the Health Department that will require a 14 day quarantine. Only those (parents of) students and staff members contacted by the Principal today are considered "close contacts" that require a 14 day quarantine by the Health Department. No other students or staff were exposed and therefore, do not require a quarantine. <u>The remainder of Brewerton Elementary will operate as normal following their regularly scheduled in-person learning according to this year's in-person learning schedule.</u>
- We were notified this afternoon (Tuesday, December 15) that a student who attends Central Square Middle School has tested positive for COVID-19. The student has been 100% remote so no contact tracing is required for students or staff.
