Dear Parents/Guardians,

We were notified this evening that a student at Hastings-Mallory Elementary has tested positive for COVID-19. The Oswego County Health Department conducted their contact tracing investigation and they determined that all of the students in that specific classroom at HME, along with all of the staff members in that classroom on Monday, December 7, 2020, will require a 14 day quarantine. In addition to the students and staff in that classroom, all of the students and staff that rode that bus on Monday, December 7 with the student that tested positive will also require a 14 day quarantine.

The District is currently contacting all of the staff members and the parents of the students that were in that classroom and rode that bus on Monday with the child that has tested positive for COVID-19 to inform them that the Health Department has quarantined them all for 14 days. The Health Department is working very hard to make all of the calls pertaining to hundreds of cases throughout all of Oswego County, and they will eventually call all of the staff and the parents of the students being quarantined pertaining to this case with full details and their end of quarantine date. Within the hour, all of the calls will have been made to all staff and students that are now quarantined. **Hastings-Mallory Elementary will still be open for in-person learning tomorrow, except for the classroom that is now 100% remote throughout their quarantine. The Principal will provide those specific parents with further details.**
