Dear Parents/Guardians,

On April 19, 2021, we sent a letter to all parents/guardians with a survey link from the Oswego County Health Department to see if there was enough interest in the Health Department running a COVID-19 vaccination clinic at Paul V. Moore High School. After receiving numerous responses, it was clear that many parents/guardians were very interested in this opportunity. On May 17, 2021, the Oswego County Health Department will be hosting a COVID-19 vaccination clinic at Paul V. Moore High School, in the large gymnasium. The Pfizer vaccine is what will be provided.

The vaccination clinic will begin for all students (**that have the consent form signed by their parent/guardian, see link below**) at 12:30 PM and run throughout the school day. From 3 PM to 6 PM, any student (**12 years old and older**) and/or any parent/guardian (or community member) that wants to be vaccinated are welcome, however, <u>it will</u> <u>be by appointment only</u>. The Health Department notified us <u>today</u> that 12 year olds and older are now eligible for the Pfizer vaccine. The vaccination clinic will be in our PVM HS gymnasium and parking will be available at the PVM HS Stadium parking lot.

The Health Department assured us that your insurance will be billed an administration fee, however <u>no one is</u> <u>responsible to pay for anything insurance does not cover</u>. There is no out of pocket cost for the vaccination. No one will be turned away if they do not have insurance. If you are not insured, you can simply check "uninsured" on the form.

<u>Schedule your appointment now by clicking on one of the following links and select a time slot.</u> The following link is for time slots during school hours for our PVM High School students <u>ONLY</u> that are 12 years or older whose parents/guardians have given their consent to have them vaccinated (see consent form above). https://apps2.health.ny.gov/doh2/applinks/cdmspr/2/counties?DateID=C1AE742F34FE02A0E0530A6C7C159054 If the time slots (below) from 3PM-6PM fill up, a parent can pick up their CSMS student, bring the student to PVM HS for their vaccination and drive the student back to CSMS after their vaccination appointment.
