Dear Parents/Guardians,

In the fall, we notified all parents/guardians of this year's protocol regarding snow days and 2-hour delays.

What happens if there is a snow day?

Snow days will operate as they have traditionally operated. If the District calls a snow day then there will be **NO** instruction on those days for **ALL** students.

What happens when there is a 2 hour delay?

- All students in the six schools within our District will still start their in-person and/or remote learning at their regular start time and **WILL NOT** be delayed at all, which includes the CiTi BOCES program located at Central Square Middle School. (**Update:** The CiTi BOCES program housed at CSMS is still fully remote until January 4)
- Middle school and high school students who arrive at either CSMS or PVM at 7:30 AM on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday will be fully remote and not come to school on a 2-hour delay.

2-hour delays will only affect the following students that will be picked up two hours later:

- All BOCES Classes/programs running outside of our District (special education and non-special education programs out of District)
- Ptech students (includes those going to Onondaga Community College)
- New Visions students
- Bishop Grimes and Living Word Academy students
- NYS School for the Deaf (located in Rome, NY)
- Tradewinds Education Center (located in Utica, NY)

The students that attend any one of the six schools in District will not be impacted at all during a 2-hour delay. If we have to call a 2-hour delay during our in-person pause because of inclement weather, the students simply log onto their device at their regularly scheduled time according to this year's schedule.
