Dear Parents/Guardians:

Given the number of students taking Regents examinations, in-house mid-term, and final exams, during the week of January 21-24, 2020, as well as the number of staff members required to score them in a timely manner, classes at Paul V. Moore High School will **not be in session** on Thursday, January 23, 2020 and Friday, January 24, 2020. Only those students scheduled to take Regents on those days are required to attend.

Paul V. Moore High School students enrolled in the following BOCES programs will also **not** have classes during Regents week, January 21-24, 2020: CTE; CTE Advantage; Strive; TASC; A+; Project Explore; PTECH; CARE; New Visions; and Bridges. Only those students scheduled to take a Regents at BOCES will attend.

Please note, the following BOCES programs at Fourth Street in Fulton: Stepping Stones, Work Study, NYSAA A+ will be in session during regents week.

Busing will be operating on a normal schedule for Paul V. Moore High School from Tuesday, January 21, 2020 through Wednesday, January 22, and we will be providing special busing on Thursday, January 23, 2020 and Friday, January 24, 2020, for Paul V. Moore High School students taking Regents exams. On Thursday and Friday, we will be transporting those students taking Regents exams to school at their normal pick-up time and we will have a special midday bus run to transport those students home.

We value and understand the necessity of providing our teachers with time to grade Regents exams, especially given they are not allowed to bring Regents exams home to score.
