Pandemic Adjustment

- The CARES Act (Federal stimulus) sent New York \$1.1
 billion for public schools
 <u>Central Square School District Amount Estimated = \$953,913</u>
- Money allocated to school districts based on share of Title I funds they received
- The State then cut each district's Foundation Aid by an amount equivalent to its stimulus money
- CARES Act Application is submitted Approved Amount = \$958,762
