Message from the CSMS Team!

With the holidays approaching we wanted to express a thank you for all of the support and hard work that our students, staff and community members have demonstrated so far this year!

With the new year approaching we wanted to take this opportunity to touch base on some of the schoolwide expectations that we follow here at CSMS. All electronic devices should be off and away during the day. This includes (airpods, bluetooth headphones, cell phones and tablets). All students should be contacting their parents from the office and should not be using any electronic devices throughout the day. We have spaced students out for lunches to cut down on quarantines in the cafeteria- it is important that students stay seated during lunch and put their mask on when they are done eating.

It is also important that students are dressed appropriately for school every day. All garments should be safe, appropriate and not disrupt or interfere with the educational process. – this includes:

- Recognize appropriateness of garments, such as strapless tops, halter tops, net tops, revealing shorts/skirts, plunging necklines (front and/or back), see-through garments are not acceptable.
- Ensure that undergarments are completely covered with outer clothing.
- Include footwear at all times. Footwear that is a safety hazard will not be allowed.
- Not include the wearing of head coverings that are distracting or cover the face, except for a medical or religious purpose.
- Not include items that may be considered vulgar, obscene, offensive, depict weapons or denigrate others on account of race, color, religion, creed, national origin, gender (identity or expression), or sex, sexual orientation or disability.
- Not promote and/or endorse the use of alcohol, tobacco, illegal drugs and/or encourage other illegal or violent activities.
