1. PRINCIPAL REPORT

- **a.** Grandparents Day new Kissflow form exceeded number of entries so the district will be extending the limits, should be back up in one day. Forms that have been received have been filled out properly. Kissflow Building use form also being affected by form entry limits and will be updated.
- **b.** A sample of the sound absorption material was shown. It will go on the walls of the gym.
