1. PRINCIPAL REPORT

- a. Covid test pick up tomorrow 8-4
- b. If mask restrictions are lifted for schools after break, Mr. Colabufo will lift them for the district as well.

2. BUDGET REVIEW/TREASURER REPORT - the budget was reviewed and approved

3. Fundraisers/PTO sponsored events

- a. BBA Basketball is off to a great start. We will be receiving a check any day for \$650. There are (3) 6 week programs x \$30 gym use fee = \$540. Plus we are getting \$5 for every CSSD student $5 \times 22 = \$110$ for a total of \$650. No program this Saturday due to the holiday weekend. Will resume next Saturday the 26th. A question was asked if Patty needed help on Saturdays (she went the first couple weeks to make sure everything ran smoothly, that people knew where to go and not to walk around the school), Patty said she was all set.
- b. Community Snow Sculpture Contest - Due to lack of snow and warmer temperatures, we will extend until March 25. We can send out an announcement with new dates. Voting will close on 4/6 and we will announce winners on 4/7.
- c. Walkathon - was supposed to be in the fall, we moved to the spring. Kerrie Proud is in charge and will work on it. Friday May 27 during classroom specials time. Kerrie will work on prizes. We will purchase T-shirts through Brewerton Special Tees even though they need a month's notice. So submissions will be due 4/22. Kerrie will check with the entire board to lower the fundraising amount for a T-shirt from \$40 to \$30.
- d. Meghan Fountain had sent out 32 letters to our community asking for donations. She has received 7 responses and is hoping for more. The Syracuse Crunch and Mets both donated 4 pack of tickets and other items. Empower, Cicero Target, Brewer Union Cafe and Ace Hardware also provided some donations. We will need to decide when to use these items, for the walk-a-thon, spring basket raffle, etc.
- e. Open House - April 21. Why is it in April instead of May? Brent was not at our meeting so we will follow up with him at our March meeting
- f. 5th grade event - meeting March 10 at the school.
- g. Spring pictures - March 1st. Check with Cindy if a flier is going home. Update: Fliers were received late Thursday afternoon and will be sent home 2/28. An email blast will be sent out to families over break and Patty will post on Facebook.
