## 1. PRINCIPAL REPORT

- a. Meet the Teacher Night Thursday, October 15. Conducted through Zoom.

- b. Halloween No parties or costume parade. No food sent in. Students can wear costumes to school. They should not be bulky or drag on the ground, no masks or face coverings other than Covid-19 mask. Students must come to school with costume on, teachers will not be assisting students with their costumes. No pretend blood or scary costumes, no sharp or threatening props or tools. AA students can wear costumes on Tuesday, October 27. Virtual students may wear costumes on Wednesday, October 28. BB students and UPK can wear costumes on Friday, October 30.
- **c.** Drop off and pick up is going well. Takes about 8-10 minutes. Staff are using the TV in the hallway and in the cafeteria to display the students being dismissed in order to improve dismissal.
