# Brewerton Elementary PTO Meeting Minutes April 10, 2019

#### 1. PRINCIPAL REPORT

- a. Part of the budget vote on May 21 will include a safety referendum that will change how people enter our school due to safety concerns. The front entrance will be changed so that visitors are buzzed into a separate hallway into the main office and then will have to be buzzed into the main part of school through another entrance. Brewerton will also have new locks installed on all the doors so they can lock easily from the inside. All exterior doors will be replaced if they are not up to code. Security film that is bullet resistance will be applied to lower windows. Security bollards will be put around the front door in order to prevent people from driving into the school. Make sure you get out and vote for the budget and safety referendum...remember polling locations have changed!
- b. The 5<sup>th</sup> grade event formerly known as extravaganza will take place at the middle school. It is tentatively scheduled for the last Friday of school on June 21. The 5<sup>th</sup> graders will be bussed to the middle school where they will eat lunch in the cafeteria. They will rotate through centers where they will participate in PE and music activities, a scavenger hunt where they will travel through the building and other activities. Snacks will be available. The students will receive a T-shirt color-coded by elementary school with the middle school logo. The PTO will donate \$100 towards a blow up obstacle course to be used that day. Students will be bussed home. Parent volunteers are needed.
