Dear Parents/Guardians,

On June 22, we notified all parents/guardians of the District's willingness to host another COVID-19 vaccination clinic at our high school. We had approximately 50 people, consisting of parents, students (12 and older), and community members that were interested in being vaccinated. Since the number was relatively low, the Central Square Walmart Pharmacy opted to contact all interested individuals directly and those vaccination appointments are scheduled for July 15 at the Central Square Walmart, not our high school.

There are several time slots still available if anyone else would like to get their first Pfizer vaccination dose on July 15. If you are interested, please feel free to contact the Walmart Pharmacy at **(315) 668-0413**, and they will schedule your first vaccination dose on July 15. As stated in my original email to all parents/guardians in the June 22 parent letter, your insurance card would be used for administrative fees but there would be no out of pocket expenses. If you do not have insurance, they would simply request a signed attestation form stating that you do not have insurance.
