Dear Parents/Guardians,

We were notified today of the following COVID-19 positive cases:

- **One student enrolled at Central Square Middle School** tested positive for COVID-19, and after the Health Department conducted their contact tracing, they provided us with the names of additional students that require a 10-day mandatory quarantine. The parents of those students are being contacted.
- **One staff member at Hastings-Mallory Elementary** tested positive for COVID-19, and after the Health Department conducted their contact tracing, they provided us with the names of additional students that require a 10-day mandatory quarantine. The parents of those students have all been contacted.
- **Four students enrolled at Paul V. Moore High School** tested positive for COVID-19, and after the Health Department conducted their contact tracing, they provided us with the names of additional students that require a 10-day mandatory quarantine. The parents of those students are currently being contacted.

As of today, September 17, we have had 33 COVID-19 cases across our District since September 7, 2021, and we were told by the Health Department that all 33 of those cases resulted from an exposure outside any of our schools, as they are recorded by the Health Department as "home exposures." It is never a good feeling reporting these COVID-19 cases, but it is important to note that we have not had any community spread within our schools.
