### Message from the Principal!

As 2022 comes to a close and we reflect upon the last year we wanted to share some things that we have learned and ways that we have continued to improve and change the instructional practices here at the middle school.

Through the use of data and hard work put in by our curriculum office and Reading departments we were able to add 3 additional reading teachers to meet the needs of our students. We revamped our reading program to offer different intervention levels of service for each grade level during the same period so that students could move through the levels of Multi-tiered systems of support (MTSS) without needing to make big changes to their schedule. Through the work of the Math and ELA audit we were able to identify gaps and plan for additional lessons of support where our students have not performed well in the past. We are happy to say that based on our strong supports and our staffs' hard work in our curriculum audits we have been make changes to our curriculum to better support our students.

We listened to our teachers and students and added additional support in the form of a Restorative Practices team member from Peaceful Schools. Ms. Meredith Needham started with us in August and has a wonderful impact on both our students and staff. She has worked with all grade levels to help with peer mediations along with working with 6th grade students specifically with social skills and strategies to help diffuse conflict. We have seen a direct correlation between the students that are seen by Ms. Needham and our reduction in disciplinary actions.

We hope that you all have a restful and much deserved holiday break with your family. We will continue to work hard to help prepare all of our students to be 21st century learners in an ever changing world. Wishing you a restful and healthy holiday break.

### Couple of reminders about FUN NIGHTS:
